In an otherwise warm winegrowing region in Southern Oregon, Irvine & Roberts focuses on the *cool climate* varietals that made Oregon famous: 100% Estate Grown Pinot Noir & Chardonnay.

Our spectacular view at Irvine & Roberts is perched at 2100' above sea level, with gentle afternoon winds that carry heat away from our hills during the peak of our growing season, placing us squarely on the cutting edge of Oregon viticulture.
